According to this report, the advantages for the environment that accrue by using LNG are manifold: the fuel not only contains no sulphur but has also causes limited emissions of CO₂, NO_x and particulate. Nevertheless, the lack of adequate bunkering infrastructure and stations has to be overcome.
