Romanian IT&C - about


Romania is one of the most attractive markets in Europe for technology investment, with a highly skilled and diversified workforce, competitive prices, and a stimulating business environment.

IT firms account for more than 6% of Romania's GDP.

Romanian IT is concentrated in ten cities in the country and according to ARIES T, IT study from 2017, we have exceeded 100,000 specialists in the field with the main locations in Bucharest, Cluj and Iași which have experienced a spectacular growth in recent years.







Romanian IT&C - about

Studies show that in the period 2011-2016 there were 50% more companies with IT profile and by 2023, specialists expect a new doubling of this number.

We estimate that the number of IT employees represents 3% of the total Romanian employees.

The IT market in Romania is 5 billion euros, being an extremely important segment in the country's economy.

The IT clusters that have signed this partnership have a total number of 566 member companies (startups, SMEs and large enterprises), which amount to almost 20,000 employees.






The importance of the ecosystems – Cluj-Napoca






Transilvania Digital Innovation Hub – the future of innovation
