

On Top Of the Wave



Luxembourg's push to become an important niche player in the maritime sector will come to the fore again, with the country represented at this year's Monaco Yacht Show (MYS) which takes place from 23rd to 26th September. Leveraging its expertise in finance, corporate, operational and tax structures, Luxembourg offers numerous simplified and tax efficient options for owners of commercial shipping. At the end of 2008, nearly 200 vessels were registered here.

These skills should be particularly well received at the MYS which is world-renowned as the only show exclusively devoted to "super yachts" of at least 25 meters in length. It will feature more than 500 exhibitors, attracting an expected 30,000+ visitors including the full range of professionals from across the industry. This year's Yacht Show will be an important event for the Ministry of the Economy & Foreign Trade and the Chamber of Commerce which brings together private and public actors to raise the sector's profile and to facilitate the exchange of ideas between local players.

// Debut at Paris Air Show

Luxembourg made its first ever appearance at the Paris Air Show in June as a way of show-casing the country's research and development achievements and ambitions in the aerospace industry. Now in its 48th year, the event has become one of the most important for the global industry, attracting participants from 48 countries. With the Grand Duchy stepping up its desire to diversify into this high-potential, high value area, contacts made at the seven-day event could prove to be valuable.

Ten local companies were present: Avitec S.à.r.l, C.T.I. Systems SA, Cae-Aviation, CPI, Luxspace S.à.r.l, Oerlikon Balzers Coating Luxembourg, PM Optima, Saturne Technology, Simelux SA and Skytation.
