

LSC presents new catalogue

The Luxembourg Scholl of Commerce's (LSC) catalogue for the second half of 2011 has been launched. It contains 24 new training courses catering to of the expressed needs of local business. The school reported 9,345 registrations in 2010, up 2.9% over 2009. The LSC is planning to launch a bachelor's programme for banking and finance, starting in the winter semester of 2011. The seven-semester course is to be offered in conjunction with FOM-Hochschule für Ökonomie und Management, of Munich, Germany. The course will be held in English and is aimed at school-leavers and skilled graduates and is intended to give students knowledge for careers in
