

Interactive DVD on doing business



The Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce last week launched a DVD on how to set up and run a business in the Grand Duchy, but with the novelty of allowing users to easily check for updates. Since the "Doing Business in Luxembourg" guide was launched 30 years ago, readers always ran the risk of the information being out of date. However, an "update" function allows users of the DVD to check for changes in laws and regulations and download the altered articles. The DVD also has the advantage over the hard copy of being easier to use and containing more information.

The ten chapters of the guide cover all aspects of business life

in Luxembourg, including how to obtain a business permit, what public aid is available, the shape of environmental and social laws, the rules for the financial sector and e-commerce...

Users can choose to have the content in English, French or German. The DVD also contains a half hour presentation of the Grand Duchy as well as the contact details of over 800 useful organisations. Content will also be available online in the near future.
